




The President's Corner by Aaron Workman

ARCHIVES

We will be adopting a cloud-based membership management system (called "Wild Apricot") that will support our technology needs as the club grows.

We will create both a public website and private pages for members and committees. The system will provide

event calendars, public and private membership directories and donation forms.

Prospective members can submit applications through the website while current members will receive automated dues renewal reminders. Member sign up activity can be tracked and payments can be processed. Club officers will be able to view member records to see membership status, event registrations, donations and more.

Events can be created and listed on the website along with a description, images and a custom online registration form. Reminders and messages can also be sent to members. There will also be both public and private forums for the exchange of ideas.

This system should greatly enhance your experience with the Club and streamline "Member Management" functions for Club officers.

In October's issue, we will be including information on how to use specific features of the new system and what to expect as we transition from our current website.

The Club officers met on August 31st.

We discussed the legal and tax implications of our non-profit status, identified newly-joined members, reviewed upcoming events and shared information and a vendor-prepared video on the new technology package we are adopting.

Officers will meet again on September 28th. If you have any topic that you would like discussed at that meeting, contact any officer prior to the meeting to get your item on the agenda.
